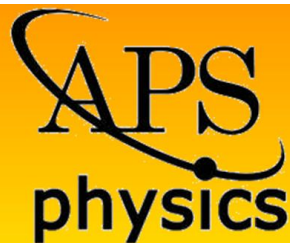

The 15th American Physical Society Conference on Shock Compression of Condensed Matter will be held on the Big Island of Hawai'i during the summer of 2007. The conference hotel is situated on the Kohala coast, 30 miles north of Kona. The scientific focus of the Conference will be on fundamental and applied research topics related to shock wave compression of condensed matter. This multidisciplinary field of research encompasses areas of physics, chemistry, materials science, mechanics, geophysics, and planetary science, and applied mathematics.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

Contributed presentations in oral and poster sessions, along with invited and plenary sessions, will be featured during the five days of the Conference. Recent advances in experimental, theoretical, and computational studies will be included in the program.

Parallel sessions will be planned for the presentations. Hardbound Conference Proceedings with the presented papers will be published after a technical review. Only papers actually presented at the Conference will be published in the Proceedings.

The abstract submission site opened on October 15, 2006 and will close on February 23, 2007. Early abstract submission is advised for international participants who may need acknowledgement of acceptance as part of the visa application process, which can take up to six months.
